WEDNESDAY

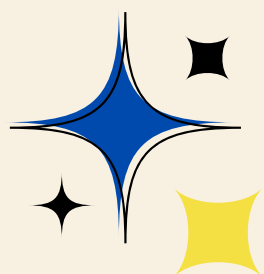
